Wenceslaus' mother Drahomira became jealous of Ludmila's influence over Wenceslaus. She had two noblemen murder Ludmila at Tetin, and part of Ludmila's story says that she was strangled with her veil. Initially Saint Ludmila was buried at St. Michael's at Tetin. Sometime before the year 1100 her remains were removed to the church of St. George at Prague Cattle.
